General Information

Adelaide is the state capital of South Australia located on the eastern shore of the Gulf of St Vincent. Adelaide and South Australia is widely regarded as the home of Australia's wine industry, being the headquarters of many wine industry organisations.

Adelaide is also host to Tasting Australia, the Australian Food Wine & Beer Experience (see above).

Within easy driving distances, Adelaide is effectively surrounded by the Adelaide Hills, Eden Valley and McLaren Vale wine regions and within a two-hour drive of the Clare [north] and the Barossa [north east] Valleys and the Fleurieu Peninsula [south].

The Adelaide area was originally home to the Kaurna aboriginal people.

Now home to a population of just over 1,000,000 people, Adelaide is unique within the context of Australia's state capitals, as it was originally founded by free settlers and was never a convict colony. This resulted in a delightful architectural heritage seen in many of the older buildings, particularly historic homes, throughout South Australia.

South Australia also became the home of many German settlers during the 1840's a fact reflected in the naming of many nearby settlements and the origins and continuing success of the wine industry.

There are plenty of diverse dining experiences within the Hindley Street and Rundle Street precincts.

Adelaide is a 2 hour flight from Sydney and 1 ¼ hours from Melbourne.
